

Session 6 – Tell God’s Story (3 Circles)

Note to leaders: In this session, again, the highest priority is to practice the tool (3 Circles), until everyone feels confident. So, first, watch Video #6. Pause the video at the 3 points indicated in the video. During each of the three pauses, pair up and have everyone practice the 3 circles with a partner. Then, if there’s time left remaining, do the Optional Bible study.

Homework: This week, practice “3 Circles” at least 3 more times. Extra credit if you train someone else how to do it. Continue: daily prayer for your list of 5, praying out loud with people who express needs or problems, using “Gatepost Statements” to let people know you really, really love God. Use “Your Story in 1 Minute” and “3 Circles” to explain further to interested people God brings to you.
