- 3. Fill in the "Personal Data Inventory". Page 4 is very important, and each question should be thought out carefully and then answered as concisely as possible.
- 4. Please read 1 Corinthians 10:13 and Romans 8:28-29.
 - What is the teaching/emphasis of 1 Cor 10:13? How can you use the information in this passage to deal with your present situation?
 - What is the teaching/emphasis of Rom 8:28-29? How can you use the information in this passage to deal with your present situation?
 - Write out both verses on a 3x5 size card. Carry the copy with you and read it several times a day. Try to memorize 1 Cor 10:13.
